Most supplies can be ordered from Talas <u>https://www.talasonline.com/</u> however, you may be able to find them less expensively elsewhere on the internet. Please LOOK at the item and check product numbers before purchasing from another source.

- Variety of papers: text weight, art weight, card stock, decorative papers, etc, larger sheets preferred. For blank book models, printer paper & cardstock may be useful.
- Cutting mat (letter size or larger)
- X-acto, olfa knife, or utility knife (various size blades may be preferable)
- Scissors (small to medium & SHARP; I like Fiskars)
- Bone folder (bone or teflon) / butter knife
- Metal cork-back ruler (recommended 18-24", tall enough to trim paper in one pass)
- Clear or see-through ruler with <sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" clearly marked (6-12")
- Double-sided tape (<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" scotch, or <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" archival 3M-415 <u>https://www.talasonline.com/3M-415-</u> <u>Tape?quantity=1&size=40</u>)
- Glue stick (UHU preferred)
- Found or drawn imagery for certain book models (magazine spreads can work)
- Tools and materials for creating desired imagery throughout your artist books
