TEXT: *The Artists Guide to Human Anatomy* by Gottfried Bammes.

Three ring binder: 1" D ring for 8 ½" x 11" paper handouts

Drawing board: 19" x 25" x ½" foam core

Drawing pad: Strathmore 500 series 18" x 24" assorted tints

Charcoal: Winsor & Newton—medium grade, small box

Charcoal pencils: General or Pitt (soft or medium)

Erasers: An assortment-pink pearl, white, kneaded

Chamois cloth

Utility knife: Any kind

Sanding block

Large clips: To be used to hold drawing pad to foam core

Ruler: 18" or 24"

Wood Dowel: 1/8" diameter—sold in different lengths at art and hardware store

Plumb line: Make this yourself. Take a piece of string two to three feet long and attach a weight such as a bolt or washer.
