- Paint – primary colors (red, yellow, blue) plus titanium white and ivory black, (optional yellow ocher, burnt sienna)
- Odorless mineral spirits
- Painting medium
- Palette
- Paint cups
- Filbert or flat brushes sizes 6, 8, 10, 12
- Supports -Gessoed panels tinted with warm earth tone suggested – *small* 8”X10” to 9”X12” or *medium* 11”X14” to 12”X16”
- 2 Pallet knives small and medium
- Brush washer
- Paper towels
- Trash bags (small used grocery bags)
- Pochade box with easel or French easel or easel with separate paintbox
- Sketch book
- Drawing pencils
- Solvent recycle jar with a lid

Optional

- Wet panel carrier
- Brush holder
- Umbrella that you can plant in the ground
