Materials:

- One piece of fabric for back 24" square
- One piece of fabric that is solid and fairly light colored for the front, same size as back
- Miscellaneous fabric scraps and old clothing you are willing to cut up
- Scissors to cut fabric and clip thread
- Hand sewing needles (Clover brand gold-eye embroidery needles, sizes 3-9, Bohin Needles Size
- 20 for Embroidery) (if you purchase a different brand, be sure needles are sharp)
- Thimble (optional)
- Embroidery hoop (optional)
- Sewing thread (gray or another neutral color)
- Perle cotton #12 for quilting (this can wait until you see your quilt top completed)
- Batting (crib size) (Warm & amp; Natural and Quilter's Dream Cotton are good brands)
- Safety Pins (curved preferred (size 2 or 3, but regular will work)
- Fabric Marker (Pilot Frixon Pens work on lighter fabrics) (water soluble marker)
- Straight pins
