On the first day of class, students should bring the following drawing materials:

1. Newsprint drawing pad, 18" x 24", rough texture, (not smooth. It usually says on the cover what texture it is).
2. Soft vine or willow charcoal, (natural sticks, not compressed sticks).
3. Soft charcoal pencil.
4. Pencil sharpener.
5. Kneaded eraser.
6. Drawing board to support drawing pad.

Other equipment, drawing and blending implements will be explained in class on the first day. As the class progresses, the use of toned papers and colored drawing medium will be explained.
