## Materials List

Please have all supplies ready for the first class meeting. Pipes/fittings for armatures can be found at any good hardware store. Plaster casting supplies will be discussed later in class.

## Sculpture Supplies

- 25lb bag water clay (dick blick)
- Set of wooden modeling tools, available on amazon. I also recommend the following:
- 11" modeling rake (<https://shop.sculpt.com/sculpture-house-11-wire-endmodeling-tool-210.html>)
- 8" hardwood tool for general modeling (<https://shop.sculpt.com/copy-of-boxwoodclay-tool-16-8in.html>)
- Calipers (dick blick)
- Spray bottle
- Metal dinner knife
- Plastic bag for keeping sculpture wet. Plastic bags for tall kitchen garbage cans are ideal.

## Armature Supplies

- 8" galvanized steel pipe ½" diameter
- Galvanized steel flange ½" diameter
- 4 gage aluminum armature wire (Blick)
- 11 ½ gage aluminum armature wire, small spool (Blick)
- (2) 1 ½" diameter hose clamps
- ¾" board with runners, supplied by Academy woodshop
