## Bring to the first class:

Notebook or sketchbook with pen/pencil

- 5-6 painting surfaces (9" X 12" or larger, up to 16" X 20")
- Large plastic container for water (ex.: quart yogurt container)
- Oil/acrylic painting palette, or pad of disposable palette sheets
- Roll of paper towels
- Palette knife (metal)
- 1 pint acrylic pourable medium (matte suggested)
- Paper towels
- 3-4 brushes in different sizes, including 1",1/2", and 1/4", flat watercolor brushes
- Heavy body acrylic paint (this is a minimal selection)
  - o Titanium White
  - o Black
  - Naphthol Red
  - o Hansa Yellow
  - o Phthalocyanine/Thalo Blue
- Additional optional colors
  - o Zinc White
  - Quinacridone Crimson
  - Ultramarine Blue
  - Yellow Ochre of Yellow Oxide
  - o Burnt Sienna
