- Painting support: canvas or board, size of your choice

- Cadmium Yellow
- Lemon Yellow
- Cadmium Red Medium
- Raw Umber
- Ultramarine Blue
- Cerulean Blue
- Cobalt Blue
- Venetian red

PAINTING SUPPORTS

- Canvas, paper, or panel
- Please feel free to bring a size comfortable to you. If you are new to still life painting, you might consider 14 by 17 canvas or something comparable in size. If you are uncertain bring several sizes.
