My book "Basic Human Anatomy", the Monacelli Press, is the required text where you can find many images and charts that deal in depth with various aspects of anatomy for figure drawing, I will also assign readings from various chapters of the book

- Good quality drawing paper: a pad of Strathmore Drawing, 400 series, 80 lb., 14" x 17" or bigger is perfect. Canson is also good. Do not use newsprint paper.
- Pencils: H HB, B. You can also bring a couple of brown/red colored pencil such as Indian Red,
  Venetian Red, Burnt Sienna, Sanguine or similar. Good brands for colored pencils are Caran D'Ache or Faber Castell.
- Kneaded eraser, plastic eraser and pencil sharpener.
- Plumb line (it can be found at any hardware store or make it yourself with a fishing weight and sewing thread)
- A notebook or sketchpad for taking notes and copying the demonstrations given during the first part of the workshop.

## Canvas & Zoom

Thank you for registering for this online course! You will only need a computer with internet connection to participate, as well as a means of photographing your artwork to upload -- a cell phone camera will suffice.

PAFA utilizes *Canvas* as their online learning platform and *Zoom* for video conferencing. *Canvas* allows you to view course content (video, images, text), upload homework assignments for instructor feedback, and communicate both with the instructor one-on-one and with other students via message boards.
