Materials:

Oil Paints

Suggested - warm and cool primary colors and a white and black. Optional - earth colors. (For example:Cool red -Alizarin Crimson or Permanent Rose, Cool Yellows -Lemon Yellow, Hansa Yellow Light Cool Blues - Phthalo Blue, Cerulean Blue Warm Reds - Cadmium Red, Cadmium Scarlet, Warm Yellows -Cadmium Yellow Deep, Indian Yellow, Warm Blues - Ultramarine Blue, Cobalt Blue. Titanium White, Earth tones - VanDyke Brown, Burnt Umber, Raw Umber, Burnt Sienna, Raw Sienna. Instructor can recommend brands if you have a preference - Winsor Newton, Gamblin, Utrecht, M. Graham, Williamsburg are reliable paints.)

[Oil Painting] Brushes, Hogs hair, Sable Painting pallet, small cups for medium and solvent, rags. Brush types - Filbert, Bright, Round with sizes of 12, 8, 6, 3

Pallet Knives - Flexable steel tip - large and small diamond shape and a multi-angled scraper. Holbein makes good flexible pallet knives but they are expensive. Bob Ross makes an inexpensive multi-angled scraper.

Canvas/Wood panels -- Primed canvas panels - suggested range - 12"X16, 16 X 20", 18" X 24", 20"X 28" or larger. Primed wood panels - suggested range - 8"X 10", 9"X 12", 11"X 14", 16" X 20". Tinted Charcoal paper and drawing pad - 9" X 12" or larger
