Sculpture Supplies

- 25lb bag water clay (dick Blick or Norristown Ceramic Supply). Red colored clay is preferred but not necessary.
- Set of wooden modeling tools, available on amazon. I also recommend the following:

 - 8" hardwood tool for general modeling
