Students can work in the Paint Media of their choice:

Oil

- Acrylic
- Watercolor
- Oil pastel(not dry)
- Oil stick

Thinners & Mediums for Oil

- Odorless (required by the school) paint thinner and/or Turpenoid or Gamsol a jar, with screw top lid is ideal for your paint thinner.
- Traditional Linseed Oil. Your painting medium works well in a baby food jar with lid.
- Do not bring varnishes or dryers.

Bushes

• Both bristle and sable or synthetic sable in varied sizes

Supports

- Canvas sizes are optional
- Some students may prefer to work on panel, either gessoed masonite or wood.
- Some may want to try one of each.
