### White All Purpose Drawing Paper:

Preferably 90LB Standard 18" X 24" Pad or Single sheets of

Stonehenge

Arches Cold Pressed

Graphite Pencils: 2H - 6B sets, better brands are:

Knife: Pen or X-acto Sanding Block Ruler: 12" or 18" Right Angle Triangle

Drawing Board: Masonite 24"X 30"

Clips:

Acco Binder Clips or Bulldog Clips, Medium size One Large Plastic Spring Clamp (Bessey Type)

Masking Tape

#### **Paint Colors:**

- Cadmium Red Medium or Napthol Red
- Quinacridone Red *or* Alizarin Crimson
- Cadmium Yellow Medium/Deep or Hansa Yellow Medium/Deep
- Cadmium Yellow Light or Hansa Yellow Light
- Ultramarine Blue
- Cerulean Blue (cheaper hue pigments may be used)
- Burnt Sienna
- Titanium or any Lead White Flake or Cremnitz White
- Mars Black (Ivory Black, if you have it already)

## Palette:

paper, prepared wood or glass (to be discussed in class)

#### **Brushes:**

minimum 3 brushes in a variety of sizes, both bristle and soft hair, natural or synthetic Filberts and flats, #6, 8, 10, 12

1.5 or 2 inch varnishing brush, also known as a chip brush

**Palette knife:** metal type preferably one with a "dog leg bend". Do not buy a plastic knife or stiff metal. The Nicole brand is inferior.

Artist Grade Stand Linseed Oil or Refined Linseed Oil

**Solvent:** Turpenoid or Gamsol

Jars—2 clean jars with lids, 1 with large mouth
Palette cup—cat food cans (or similar size) are ideal
Rags/paper—white cotton rags cut into 6-inch squares, or paper towels

## A White Canvas pad:

- 16" x 20", Recommended Brands:
  - o Blick Studio Canvas Pad
  - Utrecht Canvas Pad
  - Fredrix Canvas Pad

DO NOT buy a Painting Paper Pad such as Canson or Arches painting pads

Students having continued difficulty accessing Zoom due to issues with their device or internet connection, may wish to use an alternate device, such as a smartphone, to enter a particular day's session.

You will also receive an invitation to join *Canvas*, PAFA's online learning management system, on, or shortly before, the course start date. Your username is the email you registered with, and you will need to set up your password. Canvas is the website where the syllabus, assignments, videos, and feedback will be. You can always sign-in to Canvas and find all of the information you need about your class.
