Sketchbook, 11" x 14" or larger or loose sheets of paper for sketching

Drawing pencils, none harder than 3B

Kneaded eraser

Pencil sharpener

Board for supporting paper

Masking tape

Watercolor paper:

- one 22" x 30" sheet, cold pressed
- one 22" x 30" sheet, rough

Note: We will be cutting these sheets up so, if you like, feel free to fold or cut them in two for easier carrying.

Watercolor paint: tube colors or pan colors

Watercolor brushes, at least two:

- one round, size 5 or 6 or 7
- one round size 10 or larger
- one 3/4" flat brush

Two containers for water

Plastic or porcelain palette, for mixing colors

One or two rags

A small self-supporting (not clip-on) desk or reading light is very helpful for lighting your subject

**Note:** Try to avoid "student grade" materials as they often give poor results.
