<u>Aqueous Paints</u>: A small set of Watercolors or Gouache. See the options below and add one tube of Chinese White or White Gouache

The following color options are provided to choose from based on personal budget:

Option #1 - Minimal Mixed Palette: Red Ochre, Yellow Ochre, Ultramarine Blue

Option #2 - Minimal Primary Prismatic Palette:

Hansa Yellow Light, Phthalo Blue, Quinadridone Red, Mars Black

Option #3 - An expanded Palette: Hansa Yellow Light and Hansa Yellow Deep Cerulean Blue or Phthalo Blue and Ultramarine Blue Quinacridone Red, Opera Rose or Alizarine Crimson and Cadmium Red Light/Medium Burnt Sienna, Yellow Ochre, Red Ochre Black

<u>Watercolor palette</u>: A palette with divided paint wells. Other options are porcelain butcher tray, or flat plastic dishes. Palette must be clean and free of oil paint residue.

<u>Water Color Brushes</u>: At least the following to start. one small round sized, #4, 5, or 6 one "Mop Brush one 2" Flat one Angled Flat, $\frac{1}{2}$ ", or 1"

Bristle Brush or Chip Brush - 1" or 2"

Rags or paper towels

Auxiliary Materials:

At least two clean plastic containers for water. Disposable food containers are perfect.

Two or Three small plastic cups. These can be painting cups. To be used for distributed dry and wet materials.

Sponge, Make-Up Sponges (wedges or rounds)

Spray bottle

Gum Arabic, other Watercolor Mediums. These will be discussed in class

Students having continued difficulty accessing Zoom due to issues with their device or internet connection, may wish to use an alternate device, such as a smartphone, to enter a particular day's session.

You will also receive an invitation to join *Canvas*, PAFA's online learning management system, on, or shortly before, the course start date. Your username is the email you registered with, and you will need to set up your password. Canvas is the website where the syllabus, assignments, videos, and feedback will be.
