Suggested materials and supplies

- Telescoping lightweight easel (for oil/acrylic painters)
- Canvas collapsable chair (for water media artists)
- Painting surfaces •
- Odorless paint thinner (oil painters)
- Painting medium •
- Palette cup (double) or other small containers (oil/acrylic painters)
- Palette •
- Palette knife (metal w/offset handle for oil/acrylic painters))
- Soft paper towels or lint-free rags
- Brushes in various sizes and shapes (stiff and soft-haired for oil/acrylic painters; soft-haired for water • media artists)
- Bottled water and snacks •
- Plastic grocery bag for trash
- Suggested minimum palette of colors •
 - Titanium White
 - Yellow Ochre or Yellow Ochre Light
 - o Cadmium Yellow
 - o Cadmium Red
 - (French) Ultramarine Blue Thalo Blue

 - o Burnt Sienna
 - Ivory or Mars Black

Instructor's Note

For comfort and convenience, a backpack is recommended for carrying supplies. Keep weight and bulk minimal by choosing partly used tubes of paint and small containers of mediums and solvents.
