- Good quality drawing paper: a pad of Strathmore Drawing, 400 series, 80 lb., 14" x 17" or bigger is perfect. Canson is also good. Do not use newsprint paper.
- Pencils: H HB, B. You can also bring a couple of brown/red colored pencil such as Indian Red, Venetian Red, Burnt Sienna, Sanguine or similar. Good brands for colored pencils are Caran D'Ache or Faber Castell.
- Kneaded eraser, plastic eraser and pencil sharpener.
- Plumb line (it can be found at any hardware store or make it yourself with a fishing weight and sewing thread)
- A notebook or sketchpad for taking notes and copying the demonstrations given during the first part of the workshop.
