 - Suggested Brand: Strathmore 400 Series
 - You do not need a pad but If you already have white drawing paper in a pad 14" x 17" or larger that is fine.
- Charcoal Paper, single sheets, two White and two Gray or Tan.
 - Recommended brand, German Ingres or Strathmore
- Graphite pencils, a set that includes 2H through 6B. Bring what you have. If you are purchasing new
 - Recommended Brands: Staetdler or Faber Castell
- Vine Charcoal, soft or medium
- Black Chalk or Charcoal Pencil
 - Recommended Brands: General's, Pitt, Conte
- Sanguine and White chalk pencils (Brands: Conte, Pitt)
- Sanguine and White chalk crayons
- Erasers: All types, Kneaded, ArtGum, White or Clear Plastic, Pencil style
- Chamois – natural not synthetic
- Pen Knife or Xacto Type Knife
- Sanding Block or medium grit sandpaper
- 12 or 18" ruler
- Drawing Board or Masonite board to support paper if you want your own. We have plenty at PAFA
- Two Large Binder or Bulldog Clips
- Masking Tape
