Recommended Materials (additional items may be needed as course progresses)

- Painting surfaces (9" X 12" or larger)
- Large plastic container for water (ex.: quart yogurt container)
- Oil/acrylic painting palette, or pad of disposable palette sheets
- Paper towels
- Palette knife with offset handle (metal)
- 1-pint acrylic pourable medium (matte suggested)
- Assorted brushes in different sizes and shapes, including stiff bristle brushes and flat watercolor wash brushes
- Heavy body acrylic paint (this is a minimal selection)
 - Titanium White (large tube)
 - o Black
 - Cadmium or Naphthol Red
 - o Qinacridone Crimson
 - o Lemon Yellow, Primrose Yellow, or Hansa Yellow Light
 - o Cadmium or Hansa Yellow Medium or Deep
 - Phthalocyanine/Thalo Blue
 - Ultramarine Blue
 - Yellow Ochre of Yellow Oxide
 - o Burnt Sienna
