- Roll of paper towels
- Palette knife (metal)
- 1 pint acrylic pourable medium (matte suggested)
- Paper towels
- 3-4 brushes in different sizes, including 1", 1/2", and 1/4", flat watercolor brushes
- Heavy body acrylic paint (this is a minimal selection)
 - Titanium White
 - Black
 - Naphthol Red
 - Hansa Yellow
 - Phthalocyanine/Thalo Blue
- Additional **optional** colors
 - Zinc White
 - Quinacridone Crimson
 - Ultramarine Blue
 - Yellow Ochre or Yellow Oxide
 - Burnt Sienna
