Materials will be reviewed and demonstrated at the first class meeting.

Some basic items to have on hand will be

- Small zinc plate 4x5 or 6x8 inches for an initial first day etching
- Small newsprint pad 9x12 inches
- Sheet of good printing paper such as Stonehenge or Arches Cover, or Rives BFK
- Basic etching tools such as needle, scraper and burnisher

Anyone unfamiliar with the tools and materials may delay the purchase until after the first demonstrations. The Blick school store will be open.

Inks, printing materials, clean up materials and basic shop tools are on hand in the shop for student use.
