- You will also need scissors or an x-acto knife, tweezers, a small soft-hair brush, and a support to attach things, such as an inexpensive canvas panel in a size you are comfortable using (e.g. 11x14 or 16x20).
- For an adhesive you can use acrylic matt medium. Weekly demos will inform you what to bring for future classes.
