General:

Ink- Oil Based or Water Based

Oil- relief or intaglio ink

- Positive- very permanent, do not have to heat set
- Negative- takes a week to dry

Water Based- fabric block printing ink

- Positive- dries quickly
- Negative- must be heat set

Newsprint Pad Brayer- 4" 1" putty knife

Flat backed wood spoon or something to apply pressure for the transferring process

Paper towels

Fabric to print on- cotton, linen, silk, rayon

Surface to roll ink out on

Relief Project:

- Block to carve- easy cut (lots of different brands), linoleum, wood
- Carving Tools- linoleum cutter (speedball) or wood gauges

Stencil Project:

- Mylar or acetate
- X-acto knife

Collograph: Chipboard, mat board, thin aluminum or plexiglass

Optional:

Scraps- of fabric with texture, mesh bags (like the clementine or onion bags), craft foam, foam core, flat sticks, popsicle sticks, thin flat rocks, and any other crazy materials you have

Fabric screen printing ink (for stencil project)
