### **Suggested Materials**

#### Oil Colors:

- Titanium White
- Yellow Ochre
- Cadmium Yellow Light
- Cadmium Red
- Burnt Sienna
- Dioxazine Purple
- Ultramarine Blue
- Viridian
- Raw Umber
- Ivory Black

Brushes: 3 or 4 larger brushes - assorted filberts or flats - sizes 2, 4, 6, 8.  
2 or 3 small rounds (synthetic nylon) - sizes 1, 2, 3

Solvent: Odorless mineral spirits (Turpenoid or Gamsol), with a small cup

Oil: Linseed Oil (small bottle)

Palette: Wood or paper (approx. 11" x 14" or 12" x 16")

Palette Knife: One small palette knife

Rags: Paper towels

Canvas: Six surfaces for painting. Approx. sizes 9" x 12" – 16" x 20"
