## **MATERIALS**

(NOTE: For the benefit of less experienced students, materials will be discussed at the first class.)

- Painting surfaces of various sizes (9" X 12" to 18" X 24")
  - Odorless paint thinner
  - Painting medium
  - Palette cup (double) or other small containers
  - Palette and palette knife
  - Soft paper towels or lint-free rags
  - 4-5 bristle brushes of different sizes in round, filbert and bright shapes (plus optional soft-haired brushes)
- NOTE: natural hairs are recommended for oil painters, synthetic fibers for acrylic artists.

**The following minimal palette is recommended to start with. Additional colors will be demonstrated as the course progresses.**

Titanium White, Ivory Black, Cadmium Red (medium), Alizarin Crimson Cadmium Yellow (medium), Lemon Yellow, Ultramarine Blue, Phtalocyanine Blue
