MATERIALS

(NOTE: For the benefit of less experienced students, materials will be discussed at the first class.)

- Painting surfaces of various sizes (9" X 12" to 18" X 24")
- · Odorless paint thinner
- Painting medium
- · Palette cup (double) or other small containers
- · Palette and palette knife
- · Soft paper towels or lint-free rags
- 4-5 bristle brushes of different sizes in round, filbert and bright shapes (plus optional soft-haired brushes) NOTE: natural hairs are recommended for oil painters, synthetic fibers for acrylic artists.

The following minimal palette is recommended to start with. Additional colors will be demonstrated as the course progresses.

Titanium White, Ivory Black, Cadmium Red (medium), Alizarin Crimson Cadmium Yellow (medium), Lemon Yellow, Ultramarine Blue, Phtalocyanine Blue
