Drawing Pad – 18"x24" – nice quality white paper, should not say 'sketch' paper

- If you have a 'leftover' drawing pad -*or*- half of the sheets bring that

Dry drawing materials ;

- large, thick crayons – box of asst color

- graphite rectangle – 6B (4"x 1/2"x 1/4") - please get this size only

Eneaded eraser, white eraser

Drawing Board – masonite

Roll of blue tape

Ink supplies will be discussed – they are not needed for the first class. Supplies are listed here just to familiarize student.

Ink supplies may be purchased online or in person at Artist and Craftsman, Blick, or elsewhere;

Yasutomo Liquid Sumi Ink 2oz or similar

Yasutomo Bamboo Reed Sketching pen – size medium

1 Bamboo Sumi brush – size 12-16

Flat watercolor brush about ½" or larger – Princeton Snap brushes are fine

Strathmore Watercolor Pad – 18" x 24" 140 lb
(Item 10148-1029 at Blick) or similar

OR - Individual sheets of watercolor paper 20" x 28" (can be cut in half 20" x 14") 10 - 12 sheets
