- Titanium White
- Ivory Black
- Burnt Umber
- Burnt Sienna
- Yellow Ochre
- Hansa Yellow Medium (similar to cad yellow medium)
- Naphthol Red (similar to cad red medium)
- Quinacridone red or rose
- Ultramarine Blue
- Pthalo Blue
- Pthalo Green
